Dear North Creek Homeowners

We know that many of you have submitted requests for installing the Govee lights and are awaiting a final decision. The ACC committee, as well as the property manager (Lindsay), discussed and are providing the following guidelines.

The installation of the Govee must meet the following guidelines:

1. The light wiring must match the soffit for it to remain after the holiday season.

2. If the light wiring **doesn't match the soffit of your home, it must be removed after the holiday season** within 15 days. (**@Lindsay** can you verify the dates proposed?)

3. Any extension cord used to power the lights must not be visible/dangling.

Homeowners with installed lights whose installation fails (starts to fall/becomes detached) will be given a written notice to become compliant within 15 days to repair/remove before fine is issued. (@Lindsay can you verify the dates proposed?)

Homeowners are required to provide pictures/ diagrams of planned installation with submission of request.

Lights are allowed to be turned on during national holidays and the following festival dates:

New Year's Day January 1 Martin Luther King's Birthday 3rd Monday in January Washington's Birthday 3rd Monday in February Memorial Day last Monday in May Juneteenth National Independence Day June 19 Independence Day July 4 Labor Day 1st Monday in September Columbus Day 2nd Monday in October Veterans' Day November 11 Holiday season (2nd week in November through 2nd week January)

Festival dates can change each year <u>Holi</u> (festival of colors) - Mar 25, 2024 <u>Diwali</u> (festival of lights) - Oct 31, 2024
